Admission Criteria:

- * Must be at least 16 years of age.
- * Must have a disability that has been a barrier to employment.
- * Must want employment and want to work with RSI.
- * Must be willing to accept employment in the community.
- * Must be unemployed or underemployed.
- * Must be referred by a source that is able to pay for services and provide relevant referral information (persons without a funding source are referred to appropriate agencies).
- * Must be ambulatory to the extent that he/she is able to access available transportation, with the exception of persons who are homebound that can be employed in their homes.
- * Must not present a threat of physical harm to him/herself or to others because of aggressive behavior.
- * Must be able to attend to his/her own basic physical needs.
